Thanks to Children's Miracle Network Hospitals' longtime television partner, WITN, which produces the two-day telethon, this year's miracle children were able to share their heartwarming stories of complex illnesses and traumatic injuries and the quality medical care they received from James and Connie Maynard Children's Hospital at Vidant Medical Center. Your generous contributions helped us celebrate 34 years by raising \$1,101,707 for sick and injured children in eastern North Carolina.

The theme of this year's Children's Miracle Network Hospitals campaign has been "Give the Gift of Growing Up" which shows how important donations are in helping shape a healthier tomorrow for patients served at Maynard Children's Hospital.

The GeneXpert Xpress System provides rapid test results to clinicians to support improved patient management. A single system can store 20,000+ test results. This small instrument, about the size of a microwave, provides accurate and reliable detection for flu, strep, and RSV in as soon as 20 minutes without leaving the office which enables healthcare providers to quickly deliver targeted therapies.



ARCTIC SUN Device

High temperatures are common in patients with brain injuries because the body has difficulty maintaining temperature regulation. Infants and children in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) may require whole body cooling at some point during their hospitalization due to a head or brain injury whether birth or trauma. The Arctic Sun system allows controlled rapid cooling of the patient and the ability to maintain a steady temperature until the time of rewarming.

PICU Up! encourages kids in the PICU (Pediatric Intensive Care Unit) to get up and out of their hospital beds and transition from a culture of immobility to mobility because we believe that play is crucial for a child's health. Care in the PICU focuses on resuscitation, stabilization, management of critical disease processes, and reversal of organ failure. As a result, children are often sedated, restrained and confined to a bed for prolonged periods of time which may have several negative implications for critically ill children and their families. Study results demonstrate that creating a healing environment for children in the hospital with structured activity and mobility is safe, feasible and may have benefits for short and long term outcomes.



PICU Renovation Project

The Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) is for children with serious or life-threatening illnesses or injuries. Staffed by board-certified pediatric intensivists, surgeons, subspecialists, acute care pediatric nurse practitioners, skilled nurses and other specialized staff, the team is trained to deal with critically ill infants, children and young adults and able to quickly assess and treat their complex medical needs. Below are a just few examples of some of the enhancement your dollars are allowing us to provide:

- Updated lobby area with addition of hospitality associate space to enhance family experience
- Patient Room Upgrades
 - Remove glass walls between rooms for added patient and family privacy
 - Re-design room flow to allow for dedicated patient and family space
- Enhanced team stations to optimize work flow and improve team member experience
- Addition of family nourishment area
- Enhanced aguatic feel throughout unit to mirror newer parts of Maynard Children's Hospital to include new flooring, paint, and case work
- Addition of interactive wall to encourage early mobilization of patients
- Enlarged patient room to enhance space for quaternary level patient care
- Addition of family showers/bathrooms within the unit
